Preparing for Pesach:

Creating a Chametz Free Environment

ולא יראה לך חמץ ולא-יראה לך שאר בכל-גבלך "No Chametz may be seen in your possession, nor may leaven be seen in your possession in all your borders."

Any part of our home where Chametz was stored or placed should be cleaned.

The kitchen should be thoroughly cleaned, including the stove, fridge, microwave and oven. Cupboards and counters should be cleaned and covered.

Non Kosher-for-Pesach products should be locked away. Plates, utensils, pots and pans that are not to be used for Pesach should also be locked away.

Kashering of the Kitchen for Pesach:

Sinks: Metal sinks can be koshered. Porcelain sinks cannot and should be covered with tinfoil. The metal sink should not be used for anything hot for 24 hours before koshering. After cleaning, pour boiling water over the entire sink including the faucet and knobs.

Counter tops: Metal, marble and granite surfaces can be koshered. Clean well and then do not use for 24 hours. Pour boiling water all over them. Other surfaces should be covered with plastic or foil for Pesach.

Fridges: Clean well.

Oven: Leave unused for 24 hours before cleaning walls and racks thoroughly. Leave racks inside and run oven on highest setting for at least 40 minutes.

Gas stove: Clean burners, grates (metal frames on which the pots and pans sit) and surface between burners thoroughly. Grates can then be koshered in the oven.

Electric stove: Clean between burners thoroughly. Rub off any burnt food from the burners and turn them on to highest heat for ten minutes. The surface around the burners should be covered with tinfoil.

Microwave: It's best not to kosher a microwave for Pesach. If it must be used then clean thoroughly, leave unused for 24 hours before placing a glass of water and running on high for up to 25 minutes allowing the steam to spread throughout. The rotating tray should either be replaced or covered.

Selling of Chametz

Rabbi Oser is happy to facilitate the selling of your Chametz. This can be done by appointing him as your agent by filling in the attached form and returning it to him by April 4.

Searching and Removing of Chametz

Bedikat Chametz, the search for Chametz is done on Tuesday night, April 4. The following morning, Wednesday April 5, the Chametz should be burnt before 11:13 am. Ohel Leah Synagogue will be burning Chametz at the back of the synagogue between 10:00 am and 11:00 am. Anyone wishing to bring his or her Chametz within these times please do so. No chametz should be eaten after 10:22 am.

Travellers: If you are not intending to be in Hong Kong for Pesach, you should search for Chametz on the night before you leave, and you should also arrange for your Chametz to be sold through the Rabbi.

- All utensils must be cleaned and not used for 24 hours before kashering – only solid metal cutlery & utensil can be koshered.
- China & earthenware dishes cannot be koshered.
- No blowtorching will take place.

PASSOVER 5783 SELLING OF CHAMETZ *

I, the undersigned, hereby authorize Rabbi Asher Oser of the Ohel Leah Synagogue, Hong Kong to act on my behalf and to sell all my <u>Chametz</u> before the coming Passover, in accordance with prevalent Jewish custom, and in whatever manner he deems proper and effective.

Said <u>Chametz</u> is found especially at (list address(es))

This authorization includes the sale of <u>Chametz</u> that is in my possession, including goods that would be delivered to me during the period of April 5 through April 13 of this year, as well as <u>Chametz</u> which I may own in full or in part through shares of stock in corporations which sell or deal in <u>Chametz</u>. All of the aforesaid <u>Chametz</u> is to be sold to a non-Jew of the Rabbi's choosing, during the time that it is still legally permitted to sell <u>Chametz</u>. The purchaser has free access to the <u>Chametz</u> acquired by him, and to any storage area in my possession which will be rented to him.

The place where the <u>Chametz</u> is located is to be rented to the buyer at the Rabbi's option for the period of April 5 through April 13 of this year, and the Rabbi is authorized to act as agent for such rental. The buyer's deposit and rental fee are to be retained by the Rabbi as compensation.

This document, when accompanied by the full bill of sale and rental to be executed by the Rabbi at the time of the sale, shall be considered as the bill of sale itself with all the conditions and clauses that are enumerated in the full bill of sale. This authorization is made binding by my signature below, and by a *kinyan* (formal halakhic transaction), or by either of them alone.
